



## Declaration of Regulatory Status

### PPG2845-801B

**Intended use:** Solvent based internal liner for monobloc beverage cans

#### Assessment

- **EU Regulation No. 1935/2004/EC**

If applied and cured for the intended end-use following the recommendations of our datasheets, it is our experience and assessment, that the product PPG2845-801B will comply with the requirements set out in Article 3 of Regulation (EC) No. 1935/2004. Namely that the above mentioned product is sufficiently inert to preclude substances from being transferred to food in quantities large enough to endanger human health, or bring about an unacceptable change in the composition of the food, or a deterioration in its organoleptic properties. It is the users responsibility to ensure, that the product is applied and cured properly and that all relevant restrictions are respected under its condition of use.

- **EU: Commission Regulation (EC) No. 2023/2006 (GMP)**

We herewith confirm, that the product PPG2845-801B meets the relevant requirements of the Commission Regulation (EC) No. 2023/2006 on good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food.

- **EU: Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009**

The core requirement of Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 for cosmetic packaging is fulfilled upon confirmation that food contact materials meet the requirements as laid out in Article 3 of the Framework Regulation (EC) No. 1935/2004. Compliance with the overall requirements of the Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009 cannot be confirmed for the product PPG2845-801B, because the regulation is actually not applicable to our products. Coating ingredients are not part of cosmetics, but are constituents of a packaging and have to be considered and assessed as such. Results of migration examinations of the aforementioned product are currently not available. However, based upon knowledge of the raw materials used and compositional information, as provided to PPG by raw material suppliers, it is our experience and assessment that the dry film of the product mentioned above does not contain substances listed in annex II and annex III of the Regulation (EC) No. 1223/2009, as amended, in quantities that could endanger human health.

- **EU: CEPE Code of Practice, Framework Resolution ResAP(2004)1, Resolution ResAP(92)2**

All of the monomers and starting substances, used in the product PPG2845-801B, are listed among others in the CEPE Code of Practice, in the list 1 "Monomers" or B "Temporary Appendix to List 1 of Monomers" of the Framework Resolution ResAP(2004)1 "on coatings intended to come into contact with foodstuffs", version 3, dated 12 February 2009, or in Resolution ResAP(92)2.

- **EU/USA: Directive 94/62/EC, CONEG**

We hereby declare that in the manufacture of the above mentioned product no deliberate or knowing addition of lead, cadmium, mercury or hexavalent chromium is made by PPG Industries. Further, none of the constituent raw materials purchased by PPG Industries is specified by its supplier to contain any of these metals as significant impurities. We therefore claim compliance with the requirements of EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Directive 94/62/EC and the Confederation of North Eastern Governors (CONEG). The total content of lead, cadmium, mercury or hexavalent chromium to the final packaging article, and the combined level will be less than the 100ppm by weight of the dried coating film.

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- **BPA**

For the manufacture of the product PPG2845-801B no epoxy resin or any other BPA containing raw materials are used. We therefore confirm, that the product PPG2845-801B will meet the relevant requirements of the Regulation (EU) 2018/213 of 12 February 2018 “on the use of Bisphenol A in varnishes and coatings intended to come into contact with food”.

- **USA: US FDA 21 CFR § 175.300**

The non-volatile components of the product PPG2845-801B meet the compositional requirements of the FDA Regulation 21 CFR § 175.300 “Resinous and Polymeric coatings”.

- **HALAL**

Based upon our own knowledge of the composition of this product and its manufacturing processes, and upon information provided to PPG by our raw material suppliers, we may state to the best of our knowledge that the product PPG2845-801B does not contain any substances such as animal derivatives which are prohibited under Islamic dietary law.

- **Substances of Concern**

We hereby declare, that in the manufacture of the product no deliberate or knowing addition of the below mentioned substances is made.

- BADGE, Cyclo-di-BADGE (CdB), BFDGE, NOGE, Bisphenol F and other Bisphenols.
- Epoxidised Soyabean Oil (ESBO), Polyvinyl chloride (PVC), Polyvinylidene chloride (PVDC).
- Allergenic substances, as listed in Annex IIIa of the Directive 2003/89/EC or in Annex II of the Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011.
- Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) of the candidate list, as defined by the ECHA : separate statement available upon request.
